

## Electricity line connection completed at Gaibandha Mineral Sands Project

### Highlights

- **New electricity line successfully connected to the Gaibandha Mineral Sands Project**

**Sydney, Australia** – Mineral sands project developer, Everlast Minerals Ltd (**Everlast** or the **Company**) (ASX: EV8) is pleased to advise that a new 500kW electricity line has been successfully connected to the Company's 100%-owned, flagship Gaibandha Mineral Sands Project in Bangladesh.

The key infrastructure milestone marks a significant advancement for Everlast and is expected to support increased production capacity, operational efficiencies and underpin plant expansion initiatives, as the Company advances pilot production and potential pilot sales opportunities.

The high-voltage connection will provide a stable power supply for Everlast's existing wet and dry mineral processing plants, while also enabling integration of additional industry machinery to support ongoing development and potential scale up opportunities.

The Company would like to thank the Power Development Board of Bangladesh, Northern Electricity Supply PLC and other relevant authorities for their cooperation and support throughout the connection process. This development is expected to underpin multiple near-term expansion initiatives and underscores the Company's established relationships in-country.
